A person is locally qualified for engagement in a position in an undertaking if at all times during the term of that engagement he/she is residentially qualified, or was ordinarily resident in the Island during the whole of the period of five years immediately preceding the start of the engagement, or is the spouse of such person, or is the child of such a person who has not attained the age of 18 years (or in the case of a student, the age of 25 years)

This permission is issued without prejudice to the necessity of obtaining planning/development permission from the Environment & Public Services Minister nor does it relieve the applicant from any requirements to submit an application to the Assembly under the Licencing (Jersey) Law 1974, or to the Economic Development Minister under the Tourism (Jersey) Law 1948, in the case of premises to which those laws apply, nor does it in any way overrule or modify any condition imposed by the Housing Minister in respect of the property, or any private property restrictions affecting the land. Also, the granting of this Licence does not obviate the need to obtain permission under the Hawkers & Non-Resident Traders (Jersey) Law 1965, the Employment Agencies (Registration) (Jersey) Law 1969, the Food & Drugs (Jersey) Law 1966, the Food Hygiene (General Provisions) (Jersey) Order 1967, the Work Permit Requirements under the Immigration Act 1971, and the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 1987, where appropriate.
